<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Our Lady of Walsingham Catholic Primary School intends to offer a relevant, broad and vibrant foreign languages curriculum, that will inspire and excite our pupils. ● All pupils will be expected to achieve their full potential by encouraging high expectations and excellent standards in their foreign language learning. ● The four key language learning skills; listening, speaking, reading and writing will be taught and all necessary grammar will be covered in an age-appropriate way across the primary phase to support and develop a lifelong love of learning. ● Pupils will use and apply their learning in a variety of contexts, laying down solid foundations 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All classes will have access to a very high-quality foreign languages curriculum using the Language Angels scheme of work and resources. This will progressively develop pupils' skills in foreign languages through regularly taught and well-planned weekly lessons of 30 to 45 minutes in Key Stage 2. ● Children will progressively acquire, use and apply a growing bank of vocabulary, language skills and grammatical knowledge organised around age-appropriate topics and themes - building blocks of language into more complex, fluent and authentic language. ● Lessons offering appropriate levels of challenge and stretch will be taught at all times to ensure pupils learn effectively, continuously building their knowledge of and enthusiasm for the language they 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● By the time pupils reach Progressive units they will be exposed to much longer text and will be encouraged to formulate their own, more personalised responses based on a much wider bank of vocabulary, linguistic structures and grammatical knowledge. ● They will be able to create longer pieces of spoken and written language and are encouraged to use a variety of conjunctions, adverbs, adjectives, opinions and justifications. ● Pupils will be aware of their own learning goals and progression as each unit offers a pupil friendly overview so that all pupils can review their own learning at the start and at the end of each unit.
