These include: modelling, questioning, reviewing and scaffolding.</p> <p>Both the RE and PSHE curricula promote the moral conscience of our pupils, allowing them to be respectful and conscientious individuals by living their lives according to the values of the Gospels.</p> <p>In order to deliver this intent, we ensure pupils experience RE through a range of interactive resources, enabling them to develop their spiritual and theological perspective.</p>	<p>The impact of this will be monitored and evaluated through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• analysis of progress and attainment data</li> <li>• the voice of pupils and parents</li> <li>• teacher assessment procedures</li> <li>• regular monitoring of teaching and learning through books, learning walks and outcomes.</li> </ul>
