English



This term we're going to be retelling and adapting a story called "The Story of Pirate Tom". This is a story about a pirate called Tom who sailed the seven seas in his ship 'The Jolly Roger'. However, his ship and crew were not very jolly as they could not find any treasure. Until one day, their luck begins to change!

We are going to be looking at setting descriptions and relooking at adjectives.



Science



In Science, we are going to be starting our animal topic. Within our topic, we are going to learn about herbivores, carnivores and omnivores and sort animals out according to these groups. We are then going to each week look at the animals groups (birds, amphibians, reptiles, mammals and fish). We are going to be thinking about why these animals are categorised into these groups and compare them at the end.



Mathematics



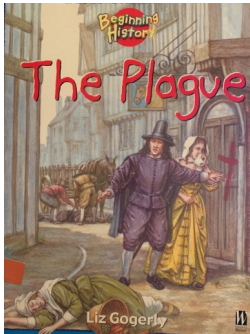
This term we will be starting by learning about place value within 20. This will include studying the teen numbers in a deeper level, ordering numbers (giving reasons as to why), using number lines, estimating and comparing. Once confident with numbers to 20, we will be using addition and subtraction with numbers to 20.

History



In History, we are looking at two topics that are closely linked.

We are going to be learning first about The Great Plague in 1665 to 1666. We're going to learn about what the plague was, what happened to people during the time of the plague, how their lives were changed, how people tried to protect themselves and how the plague spread. We are then going to be moving onto the Great Fire of London. This will continue after half term.



Art

In Art, we are going to be looking at the work of Henri Rousseau. We are going to be creating our own jungle and tiger themed piece of art using shades of colour, natural materials and drawing our own tigers.



Computing



Computing this term will be: Text and Images. The children will be learning how to change the background colour of a page, adding, resizing and positioning images (pictures) on a page. Finally, learn to type and position text on a page, and if possible using capital letters and punctuation

PE



PE will take place on a Wednesday, This term the children will be continuing Gymnastics.

Music



In this new unit, children make links between music, sounds and environments and use percussion, vocal and body sounds to represent the seaside.
