All Christians are called to follow Jesus and share the Good News with others. Christians are called to take care of each other, especially those most in need, such as the poor.

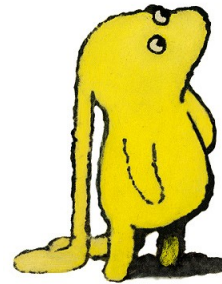


English



In English this term we are going to be learning a version of "Beegu". This is a story about a young alien who crashes into Earth, and is trying to find her way home.

We will be focussing on our usual punctuation and adjectives. We will also be looking at verbs, adverbs, using the power of three to describe and similes.



Science



In Science, we are going to be starting our animal topic. Within our topic, we are going to learn about herbivores, carnivores and omnivores and sort animals out according to these groups. We are then going to each week look at the animals groups (birds, amphibians, reptiles, mammals and fish). We are going to be thinking about why these animals are categorised into these groups and compare them at the end.



Mathematics



This term we will be starting by learning about place value within 20. This will include studying the teen numbers in a deeper level, ordering numbers (giving reasons as to why), using number lines, estimating and comparing. Once confident with numbers to 20, we will be using addition and subtraction with numbers to 20.

History



In History, we are starting a brand new topic...Explorers!

We will be learning all about Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong. We're going to learn and compare their journeys and think about why they are significant today.



Art

In Art, we are going to be looking at the work of Henri Rousseau. We are going to be creating our own jungle and tiger themed piece of art using shades of colour, natural materials and drawing our own tigers.



Computing



Computing this term will be: Text and Images. The children will be learning how to change the background colour of a page, adding, resizing and positioning images (pictures) on a page. Finally, learn to type and position text on a page, and if possible using capital letters and punctuation

PE



PE will take place on a Thursday. This term the children will be doing invasion games.

Music



In this new unit, children make links between music, sounds and environments and use percussion, vocal and body sounds to represent the seaside.
