Fasting in Lent is a way of giving things up to help others and for Catholics, CAFOD family fast day is a way of responding to this call. Fasting, praying and giving to others are ways of following Jesus' example.

English



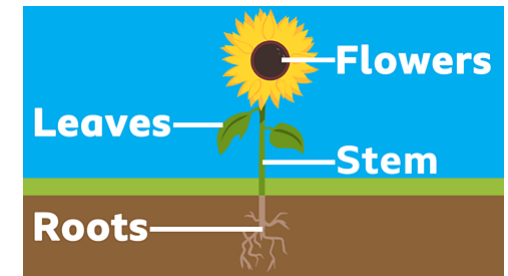
This term in English, we are looking at non-fiction. We will be learning a Diary Entry from Paddington about his adventures in London. We will be learning about writing in the first person, using the past tense and using time connectives to make our writing interesting. We will then be using these skills taught to create our own adventures for Paddington, alongside writing a recount for our History Topic.



Science



In Science we are continuing our work with animals and their groups. We will then be moving onto plants. We're going to be looking at deciduous and evergreen trees, the parts of a plant and wild and garden plants.



Mathematics



This term in Maths, we will be looking at addition and subtraction within 20. We will be learning different skills and methods to support us with this. We'll also be looking at doubles, number bonds, and continue to build our number fluency.

We will then be moving onto Place Value within 100.



## History



This term, we are going to be learning about the events that took place in London in 1665-1666.

We're going to learn about what the plague was, what happened to people during the time of the plague, how their lives were changed, how people tried to protect themselves and how the plague spread. We are then going to be moving onto the Great Fire of London.

We will be learning about the events of the Great fire, learn why the fire spread so quickly and think about how it made an impact on life today. Hopefully we will also be creating our own houses from 1666 out of junk modelling.



## Art

In Art this term we will be looking at "Flowers in Art". We'll be looking at different artists that use flowers as inspiration in their art. This includes: Monet and William Morris. We'll also be using sculpture to make a 3D flower piece of art.



## Computing



Computing this term will be: Music Creation and Comic Creation. The children will be making their own comics and pieces of music using technology.



## PE



PE will take place on a Thursday This term the children will be learning Multi-Skills.

## Music
