How Catholics around the world show honour to Mary, including diverse representations in art, sculpture and music.

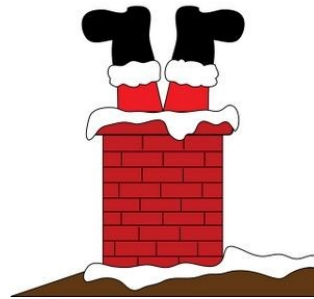
English



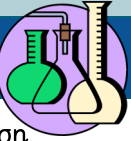
In English this term we are going to be writing our own instructions. We're going to learn the text "How to trap a Big Bad Wolf".

We're going to start our learning by thinking about what is an instruction? Then look at the features of instruction writing including using First, Next, Then, Finally and using bossy verbs.

Our Big Write will be writing instructions on "How to trap Santa"



Science



In Science, we are going to starting our Season Changes topic. We are going to be looking at the differences between autumn and winter and making comparisons between them both. We are going to think about how nature adapts to prepare for the autumn and winter seasons.



Mathematics



In Maths we are continuing with our addition and subtraction work within 10. We'll be looking at fact families, different ways to subtract (crossing out, taking away and on a number line). Using those skills, we'll then be finding parts by subtracting.

Once we are confident with addition and subtraction, we will be moving onto shape and place value within 20.

PSHE

In PSHE, this term we will be exploring who helps them to identify the 'special people' in their lives who they love and can trust. In further sessions, children will learn how to cope with various social situations and dilemmas, and the importance of saying sorry and forgiveness within relationships.

Geography



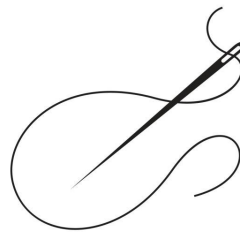
This term we will be learning about the UK. . We will be learning about which countries are part of the United Kingdom, their flags and learn what each country's capital city is.

We will then take a closer look at the individual countries and compare their human and physical features.



DT

In DT, we are going to be doing Textiles. We will be designing, creating and evaluating our own Christmas decoration. We will be joining 2 pieces of fabric together using stitches, staples and glue.



Music



In Music, this term the children are learning about Tempo. They will be using their bodies and instruments to listen and respond to pieces of music with fast and slow speeds; learn and perform a rhyme and a song focussing on fast and slow.



PE



PE will take place on a Wednesday, This term the children will be learning Gymnastics. They will also be having swimming lessons.

Computing
