Hear

The children will create their own warning tale based on the story 'Kassim and the Greedy Dragon'

The children will:

- Deepen their understanding of a text by using questions
- Retell the story using actions and a story map
- Order the events of the story
- Invent a question to ask the Greedy Dragon
- Define nouns and adjectives
- Sort parts of speech
- Identify adjectives in familiar text
- Create their own story map to support their writing
