Hear

Children will listen to the story of Holy Week from Jesus entering Jerusalem to Jesus rising from the dead.

Believe

They will learn that Jesus gave us the sacrament of reconciliation as a way to heal and restore our friendship with God. They will know that Lent is a time to prepare our hearts for Easter.

Live

The children will learn about the Easter Vigil and how the service focuses on light and water.

English



The children will create their own persuasive letter based on the book 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Drew Daywalt

The children will:

- Describe a character using adjectives to give different details

- Use Y2 key words and spellings to support their writing
- Write a letter to express their own opinion and give reasons

Plants

The children will identify and describe the basic structure of some common flowers and trees. Plant and grow their own seeds and bulb and watch how they develop over time. They will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow.
