Believe

Zelda Claw (Tale of Fear)

Use empty words to hide the threat-

something, somebody, it, a silhouette

Let the threat get closer and closer

Show the character's feelings through their reactions- *She froze*

Intensify the situation through repetition-

Deeper and deeper she walked into the forest.

Use rhetorical questions to make the reader worried- *Who had turned out the light?*

What was it?

Select verbs that connect to the emotion of the main character- *crept, tiptoed, trembled* or the threat- *grabbed, smothered, slithered*

Use dramatic adverbials to inject pace and drama- *In an instant, Without warning, Out of the blue,*

Science

Forces and magnets

- Compare how things move on different surfaces.
- Notice that some forces need contact between two objects.
- Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others.
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet.
- Describe magnets as having two poles.
- Predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.

Mathematics

Manipulating the additive relationship and securing mental calculation

Pupils develop a range of efficient strategies for adding and subtracting 2 and 3 digit numbers, learning how methods such as partitioning, adjusting, redistribution, and finding the difference support accurate calculation. They also deepen their understanding of additive relationships, using this to rearrange equations, identify knowns and unknowns, and solve multi-step problems with clear reasoning.

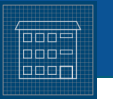
