English



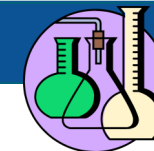
The children will continue to develop their skills of persuasive letter writing and then will base their writing around the text 'Traction Man' by Mini Grey

The children will:

- Explore openers and endings of writing
- Use *hot seating* to explore a character's thoughts and feelings
- Write their own hero story using ideas from the story text
- Use Y2 key words and spellings to support their writing
- Use verbs and adjective to make their writing more interesting
- Recognise and use contractions
