Hear

- Children will hear and retell the Gospel stories of Jesus' resurrection.

Believe

- Children will talk about why the Pope is described as 'the servant of the servants of God' making links with the ministry of Jesus.
- They will explain that the work of the Church is to continue the ministry of Jesus and to build the Kingdom of God.

Celebrate

- Celebrate that Mary is the Mother of the Church and Queen of Heaven.
- That May is a special month where we say prayers and sing hymns, including Hail Mary, the Angelus, the Rosary, the Magnificat, Ave Maria.
- We will explore artistic depictions of the Blessed Mary from different times and places.

Live

- Describe some ways in which the Church today (locally or globally) continues the work of Jesus.

Text: Why you shouldn't

Genre: Fiction— Warning Story

Toolkit: Action. Openings and Endings

Include the features:

- Show how a character is feeling through their actions and reactions- *trudged, tiptoed, glanced, sighed, glared*
- Inject action into the setting, creating atmosphere through personification and simile- *The bushes seemed like they were holding their breath. The trees lined the streets like an army.*
- Use a variety of progressive 'ing' openers to drop the reader straight into the action- *Leaping out from behind the car...*
- Extend the action using an 'ing' clause- *The trees lined the streets like an army, standing to attention*
- Vary sentence length to affect the reader- short punchy sentences to build tension and pace: *The door slammed shut. He was not alone.*

Use a wider range of dramatic fronted adverbials to advance the action- *In an instant... Without warning... Without thinking...*

Science



States of Matter

- Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
- Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C).
- Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.

Mathematics



- Pupils will compare and order mixed numbers using fractional sense.
- Pupils will make efficient choices about the order you calculate when solving addition problems (within a whole).

Emotional Well-Being

- Understand the difference between feelings and actions,
- How to manage them and what they can do to help themselves stay emotionally healthy.

Life Cycles

- Children will discuss feelings around big changes. Children will learn some coping strategies and explore how to prepare for new changes, including relying on the constancy of God.
