The children will:

- Create their own superhero using adjectives and extended noun phrases to support character description
- Know that a story has a beginning, middle and an end.
- Write their own hero story using ideas from the story text
- Use Y2 key words and spellings to support their writing
- Use verbs and onomatopoeia to provide detail to writing



Science

Animals Including Humans

The children will continue to:

- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air).
- Describe the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene

Tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to

Recognise intervals of time

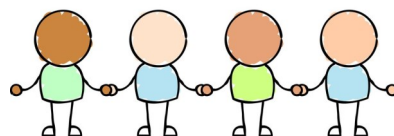
