Dialogue

- Pupils will know that the Church teaches:

Mathematics



This term in Maths, we will be continue to look at Multiplication and division. We'll continue to use the language 'lots of', 'sharing' and 'grouping' when multiplying and dividing. We'll also be continuing to practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

We also will be looking at fractions. This will be looking at halves and quarters in shapes and of amounts. Then we will be moving onto place value within 100. This includes using our tens and ones knowledge to order, sequence and finding one more and one less. Towards the end of the term, we will be learning about money and learning to tell the time to a clock and half past.



Science



In Science we are continuing to look at our senses. We're then moving onto the second part of our seasonal changes topic. This will look at seasonal changes from Spring to Summer.



English



This term we learning the story "The Three Wishes". This is a story about a fisherman who catches a magic fish which grants him 3 wishes. The fisherman's wishes though go very wrong!

We will continue to build on forming our letters correctly, adding capital letters and full stops correctly and will take a closer look at suffixes and prefixes.



Geography and History



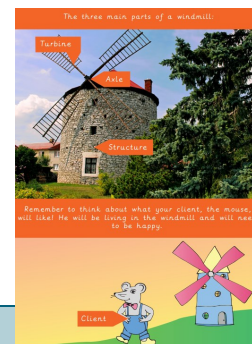
We are visiting Rockingham Castle this term, so we're going to start our term learning all about castles and then we're going to create our own shields!

We will then be moving onto our final Geography topic of the year-Around the World! In this topic, we will be comparing different countries around the world to the UK.



Design and Technology

In DT, we are going to be learning about structures and be creating a windmill. To do this we will be creating a suitable design, making a stable structure, which will eventually support the turbine, out of card, tape and glue. Then we will be making functioning turbines and axles that are assembled into the main supporting structure and finally say what is good about our windmill and what they could do better.



Computing



This term we will be continuing to introduce programming. The children will continue to learn about coding by placing instructions in the correct order, using arrows to move an onscreen object and predict and sequence directions to achieve an objective.
